The presiding officer may interrupt or terminate a participant's statement when the statement exceeds the time limit established by the Board, reveals confidential information about a minor child, or physically threatens harm. Participants are strongly encouraged to avoid comments that are personally directed, abusive or obscene.

The portion of the meeting during which the public is invited to speak shall be limited to thirty (30) minutes. The Board reserves the right to extend the time allotment....
